

MESSAGE TOLL SERVICES

TWO-POINT SERVICE

1. DEFINITIONS

Bill to Third Party - The term **ABill to Third Party@** denotes a billing arrangement by which a call may be charged to an authorized station as determined by the Telephone Company other than the station originating the call or the station where the call is terminated.

Calling Card - The term **ACalling Card@** denotes a billing arrangement by which a call may be charged to an authorized Telephone Company calling card number.

Collect Call - The term **ACollect Call@** denotes a billing arrangement by which the charge for a call may be reversed provided the charge is accepted at the called station. A collect call may be billed to a Calling Card or third party number.

Operator Person-to-Person - The term **AOperator Person-to-Person@** denotes that service where the person originating the call specifies to the Telephone Company operator, a particular person to be reached, a particular mobile station to be reached through a Miscellaneous Common Carrier attendant, or a particular station, department, or office to be reached through a Centrex or PBX attendant.

When, after the station, Miscellaneous Common Carrier mobile radio system, Centrex, or PBX called has been reached and while the connection remains established, the person originating the call requests or agrees to talk to any person other than the person specified, or to any other person or mobile station to be reached through the Miscellaneous Common Carrier attendant, or to any other station, department or office to be reached through a Centrex or PBX attendant, the classification of the call remains person-to-person.

When the person originating the call wishes arrangements made in advance with a particular party or station for the establishment of a connection at a specified time (appointment call), the call is classified as person-to-person.

TWO-POINT SERVICE (cont=d)

1. DEFINITIONS (cont=d)

Operator Person-to-Person (cont=d)

The Telephone Company does not undertake in connection with person-to-person service to bring to a station a called person who cannot be reached at a station connected to the participating Telephone Company. However, at the request of the calling party, the Telephone Company, when possible, will arrange on behalf of the calling party, for messenger service: that is, a messenger or other means to notify the called party of the call. The Telephone Company shall be reimbursed by the calling party for the amount expended for such messenger service, such charges being subject to prior authorization by the calling party to the extent that they can be determined in advance. Such charges for messenger service are in addition to the Tariff charges for the message.

Station - The term Station denotes the network control signaling unit and any other equipment provided at a customer's premises which enables a customer to establish communications connections and to effect communications through such connections.

Station-to-Station - The term Station-to-Station denotes that service where the person originating the call dials the telephone number desired or gives to the Telephone Company Operator, the telephone number of the desired station, Miscellaneous Common Carrier connecting circuit, Centrex, PBX, Centrex station, or PBX station which is reached directly rather than through a Centrex or PBX attendant, or gives only the name and address under which the number of the desired station, Miscellaneous Common Carrier connecting circuit, Centrex or PBX is listed and does not specify a particular person to be reached, nor a particular mobile station to be reached through a Miscellaneous Common Carrier attendant, nor a particular station, department or office to be reached through a Centrex or PBX attendant.

TWO-POINT SERVICE (cont=d)

1. DEFINITIONS (cont=d)

Station-to-Station (cont=d)

The classes of station-to-station service offered are as follows:

ADial Station-to-Station@ is that station-to-station service where the person originating the call from other than a Pay Telephone, where the Telephone Company provides coin supervision dials the telephone number desired and the call is completed without the assistance of a Telephone Company Operator and the call is not billed to a number other than the originating number, except: when an operator records the originating telephone number where no automatic recording equipment is available; when an Operator reaches the called telephone number where facilities are not available for dial completion; when an Operator places a call for a calling party who identifies himself as being handicapped and unable to dial the call because of his handicap; and when an Operator reestablishing a call which has been interrupted after the called number has been reached.

ACalling Card Customer Dialed@ is that station-to-station service where the person originating the call dials AO" plus the called number and charges the call to an authorized Telephone Company Calling Card Number.

AOperator Station@ is that station-to-station service where the person originating the call dials AO" plus the called number and charges the call to a third number, special billing number or makes the call collect. AOperator Station@ is also that station-to-station service where the person originating the call dials AO" and requests the operator to dial the desired number and charge the call to a Calling Card, third number, special billing number, make it a collect call or pay for the call. All Station Time and Charge Requests are also included in this category.

TWO-POINT SERVICE (cont-d)

2. CLASSES OF SERVICE

Service is offered on a Dial Station-to-Station, Calling Card Customer Dialed, Operator Station, or Operator Person-to-Person basis.

Charges for messages within these classes of service are based upon a rate per minute.

TWO-POINT SERVICE (cont=d)

3. TIMING OF MESSAGES

- a. All minute rates, referred to in this tariff, are for connection of one minute or any fraction thereof.

On Station-to-Station messages, chargeable time begins when connection is established between the calling station and the called station, Miscellaneous Common Carrier mobile radio system or PBX.

On Person-to-Person messages, chargeable time begins when connection is established between the calling person and the particular person or station specified or an agreed alternate.

- b. Chargeable time ends when the calling station hangs up@thereby releasing the network connection. If the called station hangs up@but the calling station does not, chargeable time ends when the network connection is released either by automatic timing equipment in the telephone network or by the Telephone Company Operator.
- c. Chargeable time does not include time lost because of faults or defects in the service.
- d. When exchange telephone service used for Message Toll Telephone Service is connected through a Service Terminating Arrangement or Connecting Arrangement at a customer's premises to a communications system, chargeable time for all calls begins when a call from the telecommunications network terminates in or passes through the first terminal equipment on that communications system. It is the customer's responsibility to furnish answer supervision so that chargeable time may begin.

TWO-POINT SERVICE (cont'd)

4. REVERSAL OF CHARGES (COLLECT CALLS)

The regularly established Operator Station-to-Station or Operator Person-to-Person rates apply.

5. RATES APPLICABLE ON MESSAGES PLACED BY CERTIFIED SPEECH AND/OR HEARING DISABLED

Applies to messages placed by certified speech and/or hearing disabled customers who are incapable of verbal communication and use a telecommunications device (e.g. teletypewriter or similar keyboard communications terminal device) for communicating over the message toll service network.

Certification of the speech and/or hearing disability requires the completion of an application form certified by an agency designated by the Company, or physician, otolaryngologist or licensed speech-language pathologist or audiologist.

All Dial Station-to-Station calls will be billed at the rate of:

\$.07 per minute

This rate applies for all calls made within the 234 LATA, within the State of Pennsylvania.

6. TABLE OF RATES - IntraLATA Toll Rates

a. Dial Station-to-Station and Operator Assisted Calls

All calls will be billed at the rate of:

\$.09 per minute

This rate applies for all calls made within the 234 LATA, within the State of Pennsylvania.

For Operator Assisted Calls, the following service charges apply:

7. OPTIONAL DIAL STATION-TO-STATION TOLL CALLING PLAN SERVICE

A. CIRCLE CALLING PLAN*

Circle Calling Plan is an optional calling plan which allows residential and business customers 900 minutes of toll-free calling from their home exchange to distant points whose rate centers are located within sixteen (16) miles of their home exchange rate center. Additional usage above 900 minutes will be billed at a rate of \$.07 per minute. This service is available from the exchanges listed below:

B. CIRCLE CALLING PLAN – PLUS*

Circle Calling Plan Plus is an expansion plan of the Circle Calling Plan. Circle Calling Plan Plus allows residential and business customers to increase their toll-free calling coverage area currently available under the Circle Calling Plan from their home exchange to distant points whose rate centers are located within twenty-two (22) miles of their home exchange rate center. This service is available from the exchanges listed above. Customers subscribing to Circle Calling Plan Plus must also subscribe to the Circle Calling Plan.

<u>Monthly Rate</u>
\$10.00

- * Circle Calling Plan and Circle Calling Plan Plus are not available to new subscribers after November 9, 2000. Circle Calling Plan and Circle Calling Plan Plus remain available to current subscribers with Circle Calling Plan or Circle Calling Plan Plus until such time that they discontinue Circle Calling Plan or Circle Calling Plan Plus.

C. SELECTIVE EXCHANGE CALLING PLAN

(1) DESCRIPTION OF SERVICE

This service provides for one-way dial station-to-station calling between specified exchanges.

(2) SCOPE

Selective Exchange Calling Plan Service is offered to business and residence customers for Dial Station-to-Station calls from the exchanges listed below over the routes listed.

(3) RATES

All dial station-to-station calls to the designated exchanges will be billed at a rate of \$.07 per minute. Additionally, the following rates apply for each residence and business line for each billing month for each route for which Selective Exchange Calling Plan Service is furnished.

D. METRO CALL-PAK SERVICE*

(1) DESCRIPTION OF SERVICE

This service provides for one-way dial station-to-station calling from designated exchanges to the exchanges within a designated Metro Call-Pak calling area.

(2) SCOPE

Metro Call-Pak Service is offered only to individual line residence customers served from the following exchanges. The service covers dial station-to-station calls to the exchanges within the designated Metro Call-Pak calling area.

D. METRO CALL-PAK SERVICE* (cont'd)

(3) RATES

All dial station-to-station calls to the designated calling area will be billed at a rate of \$.07 per minute. A minimum charge of \$8.00 per month applies to Metro Call-Pak Service for each resident individual line subscribing to this service.

E. TALKTIME CALLING PLANS

(1) DESCRIPTION

TalkTime Calling Plans are optional calling plans which allow residential and business customers a choice of blocks of minutes billed at a flat rate per month for toll-free calling from their home exchange to distant points whose rate centers are located within the 234 LATA. Additional usage above the selected block of minutes will be billed at a rate of \$.07 per minute. This service is available for all exchanges in the North Pittsburgh Telephone Company service area.

F. INTRALATA TOLL AUTOMATIC SAVINGS PLAN

(1) DESCRIPTION

IntraLATA Toll Automatic Savings is a business and residence toll calling arrangement which provides a percent discount for qualifying North Pittsburgh Telephone Company one-way customer directly dialed rated toll calls. Residence and business customers do not have to enroll in this toll calling arrangement to become eligible for the applicable discount.

(2) REGULATIONS

- a. This arrangement is available to individual residence and all business line customers.
- b. Customers enrolled in one of the following optional residence or business toll plans: Metro Call-Pak Service, Circle Calling, Circle Calling Plus, or Selective Exchange Calling Plan are also eligible to receive IntraLATA Toll Automatic Savings. However, completed calls rated under these optional toll plans will not be included as part of the IntraLATA Toll Automatic Savings discount calculation.
- c. Customers enrolled in any of the TalkTime Calling Plans are not eligible to receive IntraLATA Toll Automatic Savings.
- d. Residence and business calls to 976/556 are not eligible for IntraLATA Toll Automatic Savings.
- e. The discount rate (see (3) RATES following) will apply per customer billing period (as determined by the Telephone Company), per customer account.
